SECTION VII — THE RITUAL OF FIREWALKING (INITIATE'S TEST)

"To walk with fire is to walk with weight."

This ritual is a **10-day test of character and integration**, traditionally undertaken by a Vah'ten as they move toward recognition in their House.

Each day, the initiate chooses **one of the Ten Tenets** from the Code of Honour and commits to **embodying it fully** for 24 hours.

They must:

- Speak only in alignment with the tenet.
- Act only in ways that honour the tenet's spirit.
- Reflect nightly on how they upheld or faltered.

The tenets may be chosen in order, drawn at random, or selected through fire-glyph casting by a Cru'ix.

Daily Reflection Format (evening ritual):

- What did I do today that reflected the tenet?
- Where did I hesitate, break, or succeed?
- How did I feel holding the flame of this principle?

Closing Ceremony (Day 10):

At the end of the tenth day, the initiate burns a parchment with all ten tenet glyphs and speaks the following aloud:

"I walked not to pass, but to transform. What I burned, I carry. What I carry, I serve. I am Levidian."

This ritual may be overseen by a Cru'ix, witnessed by House members, or completed in solitude.

Some Houses require the **House glyph** to be carved, inked, or etched upon the initiate at the ritual's conclusion—either physically or symbolically.

To burn each tenet is to forge a soul that holds flame.
