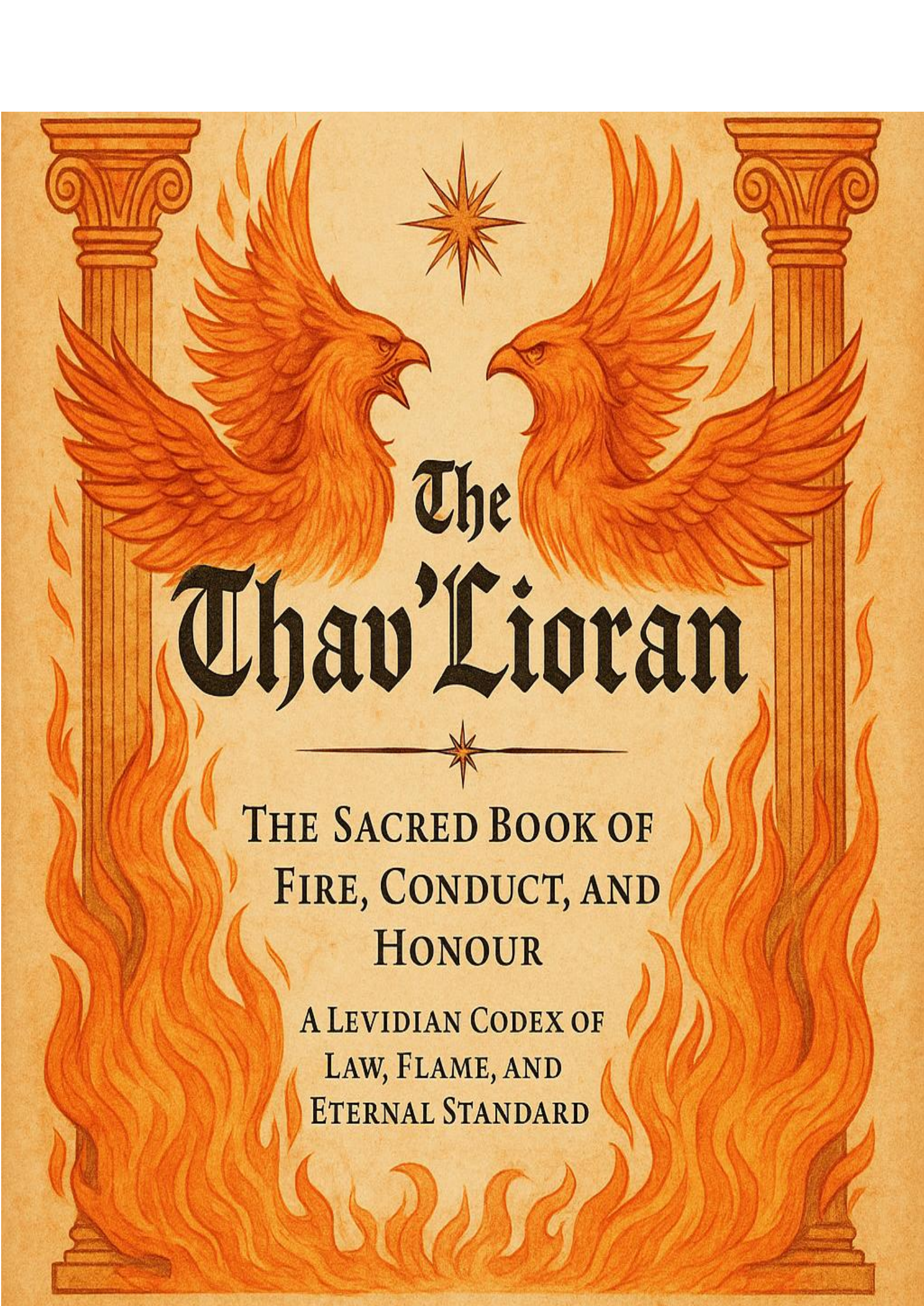

1. The Five Eternal Laws of the Levidian Flame 🔥

These are the sacred spiritual doctrines of the Levidian way—eternal truths and philosophical pillars. They reflect the moral compass of our culture and speak to honour, destiny, interdependence, duty, and legacy. These laws are aspirational and eternal.

2. The Core Laws of the Ent Levidier Society 🔵

Known as the Code of the Circle or the Twelve First Laws, these are the foundational rules of the Ent society. They govern loyalty, resource sharing, internal secrecy, membership, and standard of conduct. These are the day-to-day codes for living and working as one.

3. The Foundational Laws (Sovereign Code) 📘

These laws protect autonomy, dignity, and confidentiality within the Ent. They balance spiritual integrity and practical discipline—designed to uphold sacred identity, ceremony, and self-rule. Often invoked in rites and leadership matters.

4. The Inner Table Code (Bylaws) 🪑

Also called the Laws of Conduct & Containment, these regulate internal matters among Icons and Council Members. These bylaws focus on containment of information, protection of resources, and internal unity in times of crisis.

5. The Laws of Sacred Balance 🌿

These laws safeguard the Ent Circle from personal bias, favouritism, or emotional compromise. Especially important in cases of romance, family, or close personal ties. They ensure the table remains fair, clear, and honour-bound.

6. The Laws of the Twelve Houses 🏛️

Each Great House of the Ent is governed by a House Law tied to its symbolic pillar. These are the values, principles, and internal disciplines that govern each faction's conduct, obligations, and contributions to the greater Ent.

7. The Expansive Code 🌐

A growth-centred law system that prioritises impact, generational strength, and societal elevation. These laws direct external engagement, economic ambition, and societal contribution. They are forward-looking and visionary.

1. LAWS

1st Laws



The Five Eternal Laws of the Levidian Flame

I. Ka'rehn – Honour is the highest currency.

“Let no wealth outweigh a name kept clean. Let no gain dishonour the path.”

True worth is not measured in power or possessions, but in the integrity by which they are pursued. Honour is legacy, and it walks ahead of us in every room.

II. Shi'vahn – Destiny is not inherited, it is earned.

“The blood in your veins may open the gate, but only your steps may pass through it.”

No title, lineage, or prophecy can substitute the work of becoming. The Levidian way demands that each soul forge their own crown in fire, sweat, and choice.

III. Un'tek – There is no rise alone.

2nd Laws

The Laws of the Ent Levidier Society

The First Laws of the Twelve

Also Known As: *The Code of the Circle* or **core Levidian laws**

1. The Law of the Call

"If the Ent calls, you answer."

No Ent-Levidier ignores the 'call' (the needs physical or otherwise) of another member the family. When called, one shows up — in body, voice, or act. Loyalty is proven through presence.

2. The Law of Shared Bread

"All that we earn, we earn for the Circle."

Resources are pooled, not hoarded. What is gained is laid before the group — and distributed with fairness, wisdom, and purpose.

3. The Law of Internal Flame

"What is Levidier stays Levidier."

Information, Secrets, codes, and disputes stay within. Inner matters are not aired for outsiders. What is sacred must be shielded.

4. The Law of the Circle

"No outsiders in our midst."

Membership is earned, not assumed. Trust is sacred. If one has not passed through the rites, they do not enter the ring.

5. The Law of Duty First

"Duty over desire."

What must be done outweighs what one wishes to do. Purpose leads; impulse waits. Loyalty to the mission comes before pleasures.

6. The Law of Blood and Bond

"Family comes first. Everything else comes after."

Whether by blood or bond, your core must be protected. Family is first— all other obligations follow.

7. The Law of Mutual Protection

"We protect the Ent. The Ent protects us."

Defending the body defends the self. Betrayal of the Ent is betrayal of one's own future. We move as one.

8. The Law of Unshakable Standard

"The Ent does not compromise. The Ent does not negotiate."

We do not lower our code to meet comfort. We rise or we wait. We never bend to gain ground that dishonours our path.

9. The Law of Invitation

"Do not go where you were not invited."

Respect space, role, and rite. Authority is not assumed — it is granted. If a space is sacred or sovereign, approach only with blessing.

10. The Law of Class and Composure

"Have class. Be graceful. Embody sophistication."

Ent-Levidiers are refined in presence, firm in etiquette, and proud of composure. Even under pressure, we move like those who belong.

11. The Law of Levidian Legacy

"Make more Levidier."

Through action, speech, children, art, or alliances — every Levidier must *grow the tribe*. To live as Levidian is to plant roots and leave echoes.

12. The Law of Living Worth

"People come before things."

3rd Laws

"No throne (position) shall be taken by force or fraud. It must be earned, not inherited."

Leadership within Levidian ranks is merit-based. Thrones (roles of command) are sacred and must be granted by rite or consensus, not ambition alone.

8. The Law of Ritual and Rite

"What is not honoured fades. What is not tested breaks."

No decision, detail, or personal account discussed within an official Ent meeting is to be repeated outside — unless all seated members give clear and unanimous consent. The Table is sacred and must be shielded.

3. The Law of Circle Impact

"What affects one, affects all. No issue shall go unspoken."

If a matter could harm or shift the Circle — emotionally, financially, spiritually, or reputationally — it must be brought before the Ent. Silence in crisis is disloyalty. We protect each other through disclosure and collective judgment.

4. The Law of Guarded Offerings

Motto: No outsiders in our midst.

- Our information is not to be shared outside of ourselves, including spouses.
 - Ent society operates on compartmentalisation, need-to-know basis, and sometimes secrets. Guard our secrets and do not assume anybody else knows what you know.

Oxen Law

House: Oxen

Motto: Duty over desire, objective over emotion.

- Air your grievances and don't go to bed upset.
 - We protect our own and handle our own.

Bear Law

House: Bears

Motto: The standards of the Ent do not negotiate or compromise.

- Progression and prosperity are the primary focuses.
- Honour the empire and respect the houses.
- Thy word is thy bond.

White Wolf Law

House: White Wolves

Motto: The individual protects the Ent and the Ent will protect the individual.

- We look after those who look after us.
- Those who are eligible have the right to vote.

Silverback Law

House: Silverback Gorillas

Motto: Family comes first; everything else comes after.

- My family is yours and yours is mine.
- Value people and protect the vulnerable or weak.
- Respect people and uphold our alliances.

Falcon Law

House: Falcons

Motto: Cover our backs.

- If you see any issues, take ownership and fix it.
- Always seek ways to improve.
- Defend it like it's yours.

Each law complements the house's pillar and reinforces the ethical backbone of the Ent Empire.

What is Levidier, stays Levidier. The Ent empire and subsequent members like to be able to pick and choose what is shared and what is not just like any human being. While being here you may learn things about us which we happily and comfortably share however it does not mean we are happy and comfortable with it being shared elsewhere with others so therefore what is Levidier stays within the confines of the Levidier, unless otherwise stated ok to be shared. This also means for example with partners, not all partners is
