THE OFFICIAL STRUCTURE OF A LEVIDIAN PROFILE

Every Levidian profile is built around seven core fields.
Each field answers one specific question and represents a different aspect of a member's standing within the Society.

Together they describe who a member is, what they have achieved, what they are trusted with and how they serve Levidier.

1



LEVIDIAN GRADE

What level of trust, influence and responsibility have you earned within Levidier?

Grade is awarded through demonstrated service, leadership, stewardship and long-term contribution.

The lower the Grade, the greater the influence and responsibility.

LEVIDIAN RANK

What standard of Levidian excellence have you demonstrated?

Rank is awarded after the Apex Echelon Assessment which measures knowledge, behaviour, leadership and practical skill.

Rank measures demonstrated competency, not influence.

SOCIETY ACCESS

What areas of Levidier are you authorised to access?

Access determines which Houses, facilities, systems and information you are authorised to enter.

Access is about permission, not influence or authority.

AUTHORITY

What official powers have been entrusted to you?

Authority defines the decisions and powers you are authorised to make on behalf of Levidier.

Authority determines what you may do.

JURISDICTION

Where are you authorised to represent Levidier?

Jurisdiction defines the areas in which you may officially represent, speak or act on behalf of Levidier.

POSITION

What office or appointment do you currently hold?

Position identifies the office or appointment you hold within Levidier.

Positions may change over time.

STATUS

How are you currently serving Levidier?

Status reflects your current level of activity and visibility within the Society.

MEANING

Grade 0

The Society's most influential and trusted members.

Grade 1

Senior leaders entrusted with major responsibility.

Grade 2

Highly influential leaders overseeing significant Houses, projects or operations.

Grade 3

Established leaders with recognised responsibility.

Grade 4

Experienced members making valuable contributions.

Grade 5

Trusted members demonstrating commitment.

Grade 6

Recognised Levidians actively contributing.

Grade 7

Members beginning to establish themselves.
